Location of Proposal: 16400 SE Petrovitsky Road, Renton, WA 98058

Description of Proposal:

King County Parks and Recreation Division is proposing the installation of a new Splash Pad/Cooling Center at Petrovitsky Park. The site plan includes a new splash pad, water recirculation system, building retrofit for mechanical equipment and chemical storage, and associated site improvements. A new sidewalk will also be installed to connect two existing sidewalks. The new splash pad will be located entirely within a previously developed portion of the park between the existing soccer fields (to the south), playground (to the west), softball fields (to the north), and stormwater sand filter (to the east).
