NOTICE OF ACTION TAKEN

ISSUANCE DATE: March 27, 2026

NOTICE IS GIVEN UNDER SEPA, RCW 43.21c.080, THAT THE KING COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND PARKS TOOK THE ACTION DESCRIBED IN (2) BELOW ON MARCH 27, 2026.

- 1. Action Deadline:** Any action to set aside, enjoin, review, or otherwise challenge such action on the grounds of non-compliance with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW (State Environmental Policy Act) shall be commenced on or before 4:30 p.m. on April 24, 2026.
- 2. Description of Agency Action:** The King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks made a decision to proceed with the Petrovitsky Park Splash Pad/Cooling Center Project following this Notice of Action Taken. King County Department of Natural Resources and Parks will obtain the required permits and proceed with this project.
- 3. Description of Proposal:** King County Parks and Recreation Division is proposing the installation of a new Splash Pad/ Cooling Center at Petrovitsky Park. The site plan includes a new splash pad, water recirculation system, building retrofit for mechanical equipment and chemical storage, and associated site improvements. A new sidewalk will also be installed to connect two existing sidewalks. The new splash pad will be located entirely within a previously developed portion of the park between the existing soccer fields (to the south), playground (to the west), softball fields (to the north), and stormwater sand filter (to the east).
- 4. Location of Proposal:** 16400 SE Petrovitsky Road, Renton, WA 98058
- 5. Type of Environmental Review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA):** The King County Department of Natural Resource and Parks is the SEPA lead agency for the proposal and reviewed project information, prepared a SEPA Environmental Checklist, and determined that the project does not have probable significant adverse impacts on the environment, which resulted in issuance of a Determination of Nonsignificance on November 12, 2025 with a 14-day comment period that ended on October 29, 2025. A SEPA environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under Revised Code of Washington (RCW) 43.21C.030(2)(c).


