Marymoor Parking

Marymoor Park charges \$1.00 for parking fee per day. You may purchase a 2 month permit for \$20.00, 3 months for \$30.00, 6 months for \$55.00 or 12 months for \$100.00. Discounts available for group sales. For information on parking pass sales call 206-477-7275.

Parking violations may result in a fine of \$35.00 per violation.
Parking passes are for sale and parking violations may be paid online at kingcounty.gov/parks/marymoorparking

Field Scheduling Instructions

Review the enclosed tentative permit for your organization's field use. For returning field users, this schedule is based on your previous year's paid field uses. For new field users, the schedule is based on the ***Application for Field Use*** you submitted to the scheduling office.

After reviewing the tentative permit, please do the following:

- 1 To accept the permit without changes, reply with confirmation and the permit will be sent via DocuSign for signatures.
 - 2 To change or remove field time, contact the Marymoor or Regional Scheduling Athletic Scheduler responsible for your field use permit to make adjustments.
 - 3 To request additional dates and times, use the [Field Use Application form](#), or contact the Marymoor or Regional Scheduling Athletic Scheduler responsible for your field use permit. The Field Use Application form must be received **at least two weeks** prior to the first date requested.
- Return the signed permit via DocuSign with your \$500.00 field use deposit fee. This fee will be applied toward your final balance. The deposit fee is non-refundable after the *Seasonal Deadlines listed below*.

Permits with totals less than \$500.00 must pay in full.

Deposit Deadlines

- Spring Permits due by: January 15, 2026
- Summer Permits due by: May 15, 2026
- Fall Permits due by: July 15, 2026
- Winter Permits due by: November 15, 2026

Please return the following by the seasonal deadline.

- Tentative Field Use Permit, with desired changes indicated
- Field Use Application (for new field users and returning users requesting additional use)
- Proof of Insurance Certificate and Endorsement Page meeting King County requirements
- \$500.00 Field Use Deposit (non-refundable)

INDIVIDUAL USE PERMIT

Individuals may book up to 2-weeks in advance throughout the season. The fee is \$30.00 per hour for grass fields and \$60.00 per hour for Synthetic Turf. No bookings may be created during the same week in which the request was received. Fees in full must be paid at the time of booking. Accepted Payment Methods: Visa, MC, Discover Card.

Refunds are not given for rain outs. You have the option to rebook (one time only) within a 2-week period. Lights are automatically credited if King County rains out the field or if the group cancels lights in advance by speaking directly to scheduling staff.

YOUR FIELD PACKET MUST BE COMPLETED, SIGNED, DATED AND RETURNED BY:

- **Spring Permits due by: January 15, 2026**
- **Summer Permits due by: May 15, 2026**
- **Fall Permits due by: July 15, 2026**
- **Winter Permits due by: November 15, 2026**


If your packet is not submitted by this deadline, your dates may be returned to the general availability pool. If there is a reason you cannot meet this deadline, please contact the scheduling office.

Please be considerate! If you do not intend to use King County fields in 2026, please call and release the dates right away so others may use them.

Permit approval will occur when the following are received:

- 1 A signed permit; sent via DocuSign to complete signing.
- 2 A certificate of liability insurance naming King County as additionally insured (see pages [9](#) and [10](#) for requirements).
- 3 An endorsement page for the same certificate of insurance referencing the same policy number (see pages [9](#) and [10](#) for requirements).
- 4 Your organization's official game schedule. Game schedules are required and must be received fourteen (14) calendar days prior to your first date of use and must include accurate field dimensions. Submitting your official schedule on time will ensure accurate scheduling of lights and field preparation.

All Jamborees, sports camps, and tryout dates must be clearly outlined in your schedule. Each of these field uses must be scheduled and permitted separately.

- 5  **FULL PAYMENT IS DUE BEFORE YOUR FIRST SCHEDULED USE.** You don't have official permission to use King County athletic fields until full payment has been received along with the proper paperwork. An invoice will be issued with a copy of your approved permit after your signed tentative permit and insurance documents have been received. If changes are made to the schedule throughout the season, you will receive a final invoice or refund within 30 days of your last field use.

This policy will be strictly enforced.

Portable mounds - Must coordinate with the Athletic Scheduler at minimum 1-week in advance of scheduled field use.

Organizations must be prepared to move mounds on and off the field. Parks staff prohibited from assisting.

CANCELLATION AND LATE FEES - REGULAR LEAGUE PLAY

All regular league games and practices are subject to the following cancellation fees:

Cancelled 14 days or more before use date	\$10.00 per hr
Cancelled less than 14 days before use date	100% use fee

PLEASE NOTE: A 1.0% late fee per month will be charged on all balances 30 days past due (\$25.00 minimum late fee per month).

Tournament Procedures

SPECIAL EVENTS APPLICATION AND DEPOSIT

Tournament requests must be received (150) days in advance. If application is submitted (60) days or fewer prior to the event, it may be denied. The deposit for each tournament must be submitted to the scheduling office upon event approval. We accept Visa, MC, Discover Card, Checks for Regional and Marymoor field use may be sent to: Marymoor Business Unit 6046 W. Lake Sammamish Pkwy NE Redmond 98052. All deposits will apply toward the field use balance; however, **this deposit is non-refundable.**

TOURNAMENT AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Final tournament schedule must be submitted to the scheduling office, no later than: 12:00 p.m. (noon) fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the first date of the tournament. Submitting your official schedule on time will ensure accurate scheduling. Schedules need to include field preps.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE CHANGES

Changes to the field use, base lengths and lights will not be accepted after the final schedule is received and confirmed.

TOURNAMENT CANCELLATIONS

Field use cancelled before receipt of the final schedule will be charged a \$15.00 per hour cancellation fee after event approval. Changes to the field use and lights will not be accepted after the final schedule is received.

A CERTIFICATE OF LIABILITY INSURANCE AND ENDORSEMENT PAGE, naming King County as additional insured, is required 6-weeks before the scheduled tournament. See enclosed [page 9](#) of Insurance requirements.

VENDOR PACKET INFO/VENDOR REQUIREMENTS

If you would like to serve or sell any food items, or sell merchandise at an athletic event, **you must seek prior approval.** If your request is granted, you may need to provide a health permit from the King County Health Department and extra insurance. There is a concession fee paid to King County Parks of 20% of gross revenue; \$40 minimum. For more information, please contact the scheduling office.

Concession information must appear on your facility use permit. You are required to have your concession permit at your event, or you will not be allowed to set up your concession stand.

Credits and Cancellations

CREDIT ADJUSTMENTS

All credit adjustments must be submitted in writing or email by your scheduling representative within five working days of a lighting failure or onsite rainout cancellation. Unconfirmed schedule changes will not be credited to your organization.

CANCELLATION OF LIGHTS

An automated lighting system is available at these locations:

- Marymoor Park
- Ravensdale Park
- Big Finn Hill Park
- Redmond Ridge Park
- Petrovitsky Park
- Preston Park
- Steve Cox Memorial Park

We are able to credit your organization for lights scheduled at these parks if you call in for cancellation during office hours between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. (only if we're able to turn the lights off). If you cannot reach one of the office staff, please call the appropriate lighting system cell number:

A permit is required to turn lights on or off after hours. Call the above numbers with your name, organization name and permit #. If you do not reach staff directly, please leave your phone number for a return call.

Note: Parks maintenance staff is not available after hours to address lighting problems. Assistance can only be provided with the automated lighting system.

Insurance Requirements

To use King County facilities, your organization must have a current Certificate of Insurance and Endorsement page on file with the King County Parks and Recreation, as required by law in King County Code, chapter 7.12 paragraph 110. If you do not have your certificate of insurance and endorsement page on file, you do not have permission to use King County fields for organized sports activities.

- You will provide at no cost to King County, a Certificate of Insurance and Endorsement page naming

King County, Its Officers, Officials, Employees, and Agents

as additional insured. The Endorsement page must refer back to the policy number on the Certificate of Insurance.

- A sample certificate page and endorsement page are included in this mailing.
- King County Code, **7.12.110 Liability Insurance**: *During all periods of use, persons using facilities by permit shall, except when a waiver is obtained from the department, obtain and maintain public liability insurance acceptable to the county and/or other insurance necessary to protect the public and the county on premises to be used, with limits of liability not less than: one million dollars per each person personal injury; one million dollars each occurrence personal injury; one million dollars per each occurrence property damage; or a combined single-limit personal injury or property damage, or both, liability of two million dollars per occurrence. Persons shall provide a certificate of insurance, or, upon written request of the county, a duplicate of the policy, as evidence of the insurance protection provided. The insurance shall not be cancelled or reduced without prior written notice to the county at least thirty days in advance of the cancellation. (Ord. 19771 § 9, 2024; Ord. 12003 § 4, 1995; Ord. 6798 § 11, 1984).*

Your Field Use Application or permit will not be considered valid until your Certificate of Insurance plus an Endorsement Document are on file in our office.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS ARE:

- Limits of liability will meet requirements listed in the King County Code as stated on [page 9](#).
- Certificate and Endorsement may be mailed or faxed to the appropriate scheduling office.
- This process must be completed two weeks prior to first scheduled usage or you do not have permission to use King County Park’s athletic fields.

If you have any questions concerning insurance requirements, please contact the scheduling office.

Supplemental Maintenance Agreements

Supplemental Maintenance Agreements (SMA’s) are seasonal/short-term agreements with a volunteer group that authorize the volunteer group to perform limited maintenance tasks on athletic ball fields above the level/or in addition to the level of maintenance that King County Park’s maintenance staff provides. All volunteers must attend a training session and will be issued a card authorizing the volunteer to perform only those duties specified in the agreement.

If your organization is interested in performing specific maintenance tasks specified in the agreement for the 2026 season, please contact the scheduling office for the appropriate staff member and telephone number for your region. **No one has authorization to do any maintenance related work on King County athletic fields without prior permission and training.**

If you have questions about SMA’s or wish to view a sample copy of a Supplemental Maintenance Agreement, please contact the scheduling office.

Field Use Rules and Guidelines

We welcome your use of King County Park's facilities and appreciate your cooperation in making our parks a safe, positive environment for all users.

FIELD CLOSURE INFORMATION - RAINOUTS

Field closures may result from inclement weather, poor playing conditions or field damage which may cause hazardous safety considerations for the public or excessive repair work to bring the field back to a playable condition. It is the organization's responsibility to obtain field closure and rainout information by checking the Statusfy App, statusfy.com, or by calling 206-205-6722 which will be updated by field staff. This app will be updated weekdays by 3:00 p.m. On weekends the line will be updated by 7:00 a.m. for early games and, if conditions change, also at 12:00 p.m. (noon) for late afternoon games and 3:00 p.m. for evening games. The rainout updates will announce the day and date.

IMPORTANT: If the field has been rained out by Park's staff, **STAY OFF THE FIELD!** You are not allowed to try to prep the field to get it into playing condition even if the field has dried out since the rainout was posted. Any foreign materials such as bark, sand, dirt, kitty litter, diamond dry, etc are strictly prohibited. **Field repair fee: \$65 per hour.** Repeat offenses may result in revocation of field use privileges.

SYNTHETIC TURF FIELD RULES

- Drinking water is permitted on fields. Food and beverages must be consumed off the field surface.
- Sunflower seeds, gum and tobacco products are prohibited in all areas
- Metal Cleats are prohibited
- Pets are not allowed on fields
- Bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades and scooters are prohibited on fields
- Fireworks, model rockets and other explosive devices are prohibited in the park
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in all areas

FIELD LIGHTING PROBLEMS

Please see [page 8](#) for information on reporting problems with scheduled field lighting at the following fields:

- Big Finn • Marymoor Park • Petrovitsky Park • Ravensdale Park
- Hill Park • Redmond Ridge • Steve Cox Memorial Park • Preston Park

These fields have remote controlled light timers which under normal circumstances may be adjusted after hours.

Note: Parks maintenance staff is not available after hours.

NO SHOWS

Non-communicated no shows are highly discouraged. If a reservation will not be utilized, users are expected to notify King County Parks staff as soon as possible so the field may be made available to others.

Frequent or repeated no shows without prior notice may result in loss of scheduling privileges or denial of future field reservation requests.

We Are Serious About Enforcing the Law.

- King County Sheriff, local police and Park Rangers routinely patrol County parks.
- Parks personnel will report violators.
- Violations may result in citations and/or revocation of field use privileges.



TOBACCO PRODUCTS BANNED

In July 2012, the King County Council passed KC Ordinance 17375 banning the use of tobacco products in high-use areas of King County Parks facilities.

Athletic fields, sport courts, play areas, picnic shelters and parking lots are examples of high-use areas. Tobacco products such as chewing tobacco, cigarettes, cigars, and pipe tobacco are not allowed in these areas.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN KING COUNTY PARK FACILITIES WITHOUT A PERMIT. King County Code 7.12.285
Alcoholic beverages prohibitions - exceptions:

A. A person shall not sell, open, or possess alcoholic beverages in an open container or consume any alcoholic beverage in a park area or associated marine area except in areas designated and posted by the director. Alcohol sales, possession, and consumption shall comply with Washington state laws and regulations.

B. Entering or remaining in a park area or associated marine area while in a state of intoxication is prohibited. (Ord. 19771 § 23, 2024).

LITTER CONTROL

Leagues will be held responsible for excessive litter left after games and practices. We recommend that the home team be made responsible for cleaning up the area before they leave. Maintenance will monitor and report abuses of this policy and a clean-up fee will be imposed when excessive maintenance time is needed to clean the area. **Clean-up fee: \$65.00 per hour.** Repeat offenses may result in revocation of field use privileges.

FAQs

LATE PAYMENT PENALTY

Full payment is due upon confirmation of scheduling. Do not wait to pay. All fee adjustments will be billed or credited at the end of your season. 1.0% late fee per month will be charged on all balances 30 days past due (\$25.00 minimum late fee per month). See [page 6](#).

JAMBOREE, SPORTS CAMPS, AND TRYOUTS

Jamborees, sports camps, and tryout dates must be clearly outlined in your game schedule. These are not considered simply practices and maintenance staff needs to be alerted.

LIGHT FAILURE

When you have a problem with scheduled field lights, call the number below:

Lights come on 15 minutes before your scheduled use. **Please do not call us before that time.**

RAINOUTS

When maintenance has rained out a field, **stay off the entire field.** Do not assume it is ok to practice because the field has dried out. The field may not be in safe condition or use may damage the field resulting in longer closure times. Field repair fee: \$65 per hour.

SUPPLEMENTAL MAINTENANCE

Sign up for a Supplemental Maintenance Agreement. Once trained your group will be allowed to rake, line, and move bases. Training cards will be issued to those that attend a mandatory training session. All others are not allowed to do any manual labor on County fields.

INFIELD SOIL

Do not add any foreign materials to the infield mix such as bark, sand, dirt, kitty litter, diamond dry, etc. This causes major maintenance problems that cost the County thousands of dollars each year.

DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS

Only County vehicles are allowed on Parks property other than in designated parking areas. Do not remove bollards and drive onto park property to unload or park. You will need to carry all items from the parking area to the fields. Bring a wagon or cart for heavy items. Do not block roadways. Your vehicle may be cited by police or towed.

ANTI-DISCRIMINATION POLICY

In all use, hiring or employment made possible or resulting from this permit, the Permittee agrees that:

A: There shall be no discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of sex, age, creed, national origin, marital status, sexual preference or the presence of any sensory, mental or physical handicap, unless based upon a bona fide occupational qualification, and this requirement shall apply to but not be limited to the following: employment, advertising, lay-off or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

B: No person shall be denied, or subjected to discrimination to, receipt of the benefit of any services or activities made possible by or resulting from this permit on the ground of sex, race, color, creed, national origin, age, except minimum age and retirement provisions, marital status, sexual preference or the presence of any sensory, mental or physical handicap.

C: Any violation of this provision shall be considered a violation of a material provision of this permit and shall be grounds for cancellation, termination, or suspension in whole or in part, of the permit by the county and may result in ineligibility for further county permits.

D: The Permittee shall comply with all applicable anti-discrimination and affirmative action ordinances, laws and statutes, including but not limited to King County Ordinance 5983, 4258, and R.C.W. Chapter 49.60.
