Garbage Disposal

King County operates 8 transfer stations, 2 drop boxes, and the Cedar Hills Regional Landfill. Our facilities are open to residential self haulers that live or work within King County's service area. Please use this guide for information on accepted materials and location information.

When using our facilities:

- Keep children and pets in vehicle
- No smoking
- Read and follow advisory signs
- Watch for moving vehicles
- Use extreme caution
- Turn off your cell phone while driving



<p>Appliances <i>Non-commercial refrigerant-type (Residential air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, etc.)</i> Residential only. Must be empty. Limit 4 per visit. \$30 each appliance</p>											
<p>Appliances <i>Non-commercial major non-refrigerant type (Residential dishwashers, dryers, furnaces, stoves, washers, etc.)</i> Residential only. Must be empty. Limit 4 per visit. Dishwashers made of 50% or more plastic are not accepted for recycling but are accepted as garbage. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Appliances <i>Small (blenders, irons, microwaves, etc.)</i> To recycle: Must be at least 50% metal. Must be empty. Put in scrap metal bin. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Asbestos ** Not accepted. Visit pscleanair.org for more information.</p>											
<p>Batteries <i>Vehicle, marine, rechargeable, button</i> Accepted at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off only. Combined total of 5 vehicle/marine batteries per vehicle load per day. \$0 at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off</p>											
<p>Batteries <i>Household (alkaline AA, AAA, C, D, etc.)</i> \$0 at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off</p>											
<p>Cans <i>Aluminum, steel, tin (place with glass bottles, paper, and plastic containers)</i> To recycle: Must be empty – no liquid or food. No plastic bags. No bagged recyclables; keep them loose. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Cardboard <i>Corrugated boxes</i> To recycle: Must be empty and flattened. No wax-coated or food-soiled cardboard. No Styrofoam™, polystyrene, or packing peanuts. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Computers <i>Computers, laptops, monitors, tablets, e-readers, portable DVD players</i> Not accepted. Contact 1-800-732-9253, ecyclewashington.org for free recycling options.</p>											
<p>Construction and demolition (C&D) debris <i>Carpet, drywall, insulation, roofing, etc.</i> No dump vehicles or dump trailers (except at Vashon) unless C&D debris is less than 20% of the load. Item size limits apply. Garbage fee applies</p>											
<p>Dead animals <i>Up to 15 pounds</i> Larger than 15 pounds requires waste clearance. ** Garbage fee applies</p>

<p>Dirt <i>Soil or mud</i></p> <p>Must be uncontaminated by diesel, gas, oil, human waste (i.e. septic), or other hazardous materials. Limit: One pickup truck load from residential customers only. Contaminated dirt requires a waste clearance.** Garbage fee applies</p>											
<p>Flags</p> <p>Contact VFV: 1-816-756-3390 or vfw.org. \$0 fee</p>											
<p>Fluorescent lights and other mercury-containing bulbs and tubes</p> <p>To recycle: Limit of 15 bulbs/tubes per vehicle per day. Broken bulbs must be sealed in a bag or box. No incandescent, halogen, or LED bulbs. For more recycling options visit lightrecycle.org. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Glass bottles and jars</p> <p>To recycle: Place with cans, paper, and plastic containers. Must be empty – no liquid or food. No plastic bags. No bagged recyclables; keep them loose. No ceramics, glassware, mirrors, light bulbs, or windows. No lids on glass bottles or jars. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Glass windows, mirrors, etc.</p> <p>For reuse options visit kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith. Garbage fee applies</p>											
<p>Hazardous Waste <i>Usually labeled Caution, Warning, Danger, or Poison. Includes thermometers and thermostats.</i></p> <p>Accepted at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off only. No containers larger than 5 gallons. Households limited to 50 gallons a day. (Exception: 25 gallons maximum for gas, oil, and antifreeze). Visit kingcountyhazwastewa.gov for more information. \$0 at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off</p>											
<p>Mattresses, futons, or box springs</p> <p>Combined total of 6 pieces per customer per day. More than 6 requires waste clearance.** To recycle at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, Factoria, Shoreline, Vashon: No wet mattresses. Torn or stained OK. Handling fee applies</p>											
<p>Metal <i>Scrap (lawnmowers, BBQ grills, building/electrical/plumbing parts, microwaves, small appliances, bicycles, bicycle parts, etc.)</i></p> <p>Must be at least 50% metal. No paint cans, sealed drums, pressurized containers, concrete, or barbed wire. No ammunition or shell casings. Containers must be empty. Remove any fluids. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Motor vehicles and major parts (with VIN numbers)</p> <p>Not accepted. Visit kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith for options.</p>											
<p>Packing peanuts</p> <p>Must be bagged and securely tied. Garbage fee applies</p>

<p>Paint Latex No liquid – must be solidified or dried out. Visit paintcare.org/wa for take-back locations. Garbage fee applies</p>											
<p>Paint Oil based Accepted at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off only. No containers larger than 5 gallons. Households limited to 50 gallons a day. Visit kingcountyhazwastewa.gov for more information. \$0 at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off</p>											
<p>Paper Books, copy paper, junk mail, magazines, milk cartons, newspapers, etc. (place with cans, glass bottles, and plastic containers) To recycle: No food-soiled or wet paper. No paper towels or napkins. No plastic bags. Food and drink containers must be empty. No bagged recyclables; keep them loose. No shredded paper. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Plastic containers Bottles, cups, jugs, etc. To recycle: Place with cans, glass, bottles and paper. Must be empty – no liquid or food. No toxic product containers. No plastic bags. No bagged recyclables; keep them loose. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Plastic wrap Bubble, pallet, shrink, stretch wrap; plastic "air" pillows and plastic bags (bread, dry cleaner, grocery, newspaper, produce, retail) To recycle: Must be clean, dry, and empty. No food, liquid, candy or chip bags, black trash bags, biodegradable or compostable bags, pre-washed salad bags, labels, or tape. No commercial loads; residential only. Visit kingcounty.gov/plastic-bags-wrap for recycling options. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Printers, fax machines, scanners For recycling options visit kingcounty.gov/takeitback. Garbage fee applies</p>											
<p>Propane and other compressed gas tanks Accepted at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off only. No tank larger than 8 gallons. Limit: 5 tanks or cylinders, regardless of size. \$0 at Factoria Hazardous Waste Drop-off</p>											
<p>Sharps Home-generated only (needles, syringes, etc.) Limit two containers per visit. Accepted in designated bin. Must be in a puncture resistant, secured container labeled "sharps." No loose sharps. Commercially generated sharps accepted at Vashon and Cedar Hills Regional Landfill with a waste clearance.** Visit kingcounty.gov/WhatDoIDoWith for more information. \$0 to recycle</p>											
<p>Styrofoam™ blocks and coolers Sometimes called polystyrene To recycle: Must be clean, dry, and empty. No packing peanuts. No food, liquid, food packaging, stickers, or tape. No commercial loads; residential only. \$0 to recycle</p>

Televisions

Not accepted. Contact 1-800-732-9253, ecyclewashington.org for free recycling options.

Textiles | *Clothing, fabric, shoes, curtains, linens, pillows, stuffed animals, small throw rugs, etc.*

To recycle: Reusable and torn, worn, stained items accepted. Single shoes OK. No carpet or items that are wet, mildewed, or soiled with hazardous materials.

\$0 to recycle

Tires

Tires with rims OK. Limit 4 per customer. No large truck tires. At Bow Lake, Factoria, and Shoreline: Put tires in tires bin.

Garbage fee applies

Wood | *Treated, painted, stained (railroad ties, etc.)*

No dump trucks or dump trailers (except at Vashon) unless the painted, stained, or treated wood is less than 20% of the load. **Garbage fee applies**

Wood (Clean) | *Unpainted, unstained, untreated (crates, lumber, pallets, particle board, plywood)*

To recycle: No yard waste such as branches, stumps, or wood rounds. No sod, soil, rocks, or plastic bags. No metal hinges or latches. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and wood will be charged the garbage fee.

Reduced fee if recycled

Yard waste | *Branches, brush, grass, leaves, stumps, wood rounds, etc.*

To recycle: No sod, soil, rocks, or plastic bags. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and yard waste will be charged the garbage fee. No branches larger than 4 inches in diameter. **Reduced fee if recycled**

Fees EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2026

Cleanup LIFT Discount

\$20.00 off the cost to dispose of garbage and each type of recyclable item, each visit. Only for residential customers currently enrolled in ORCA LIFT, ProviderOne, or EBT. Show your card as you enter and exit the facility.

- 1 Solid waste commercial collection companies pay only the basic fee at King County solid waste disposal facilities.
- 2 The King County Board of Health has approved increases in the surcharge that funds hazardous waste programs.
- 3 The total minimum fee is rounded to the nearest \$0.25 per King County Code 10.12.030.

Note: Sedans and two-door hatchbacks pay only the minimum fee. All other vehicles will be weighed in and out, and charged for the actual weight disposed based on the per ton fee, with a minimum fee of \$40.25.

Mattress Handling Fee

Mattress, futon, and box spring: \$30.00 each. This handling fee applies at all facilities. Recycling offered at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, Factoria, Shoreline, and Vashon.

Secure your load

A secured load of solid waste has been securely fastened, covered, or both in a manner that will prevent the covering or any part of the load from becoming loose, detached or leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is moving.



At King County facilities, unsecured loads will be assessed a \$25 fee per *King County Code 10.12.040*.
