

Do you know that **Hazardous Waste** cannot go in the trash or down the drain?



If a product has a label with one or more of these **words** it's hazardous waste!



Your business can receive no-cost disposal up to four times a year if eligible. To qualify, your business must be located in King County, produce less than 220 lbs of hazardous waste per month and store less than 2,200 lbs of hazardous waste per year. Qualifying businesses can make up to 4 visits per year. Load limits are 25 gallons or 220 pounds per visit. Fill out a **Business Disposal Form** on our website prior to drop-off.

TIPS FOR TRANSPORT

- Never mix different types of wastes together.
- Keep wastes in their original containers or in appropriately labeled containers.
- Keep items sealed and upright in a leak-proof carrier packed with newspaper or absorbent material.


