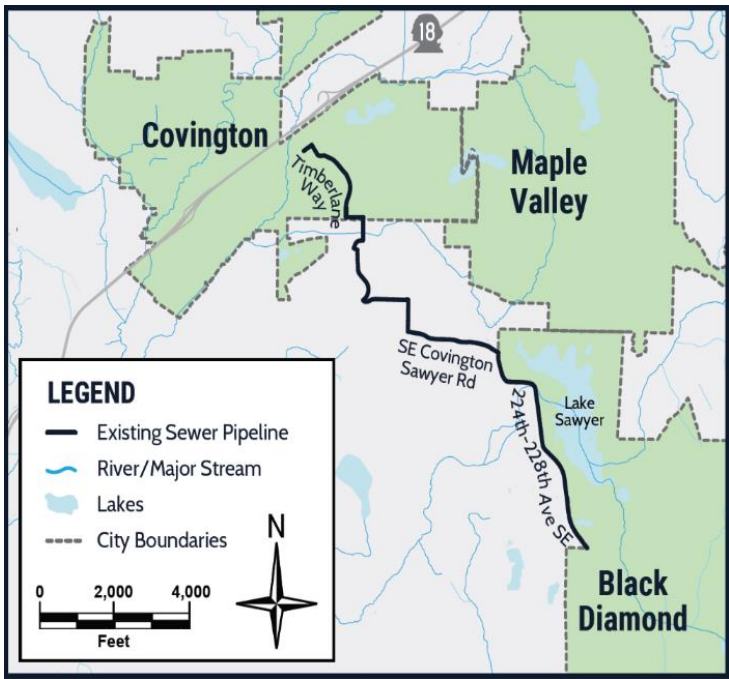


## Getting started: Understanding site conditions and community needs

Black Diamond is one of the fastest-growing communities in the Puget Sound region. In 1992, King County built a regional sewer pipe to serve the area’s much smaller population at the time. Today, we need to upgrade the existing sewer pipe to support Black Diamond's growing needs.

We are in the early stages of design for the new pipe. Over the past couple of weeks, we have been surveying the project area to understand existing conditions. This information will help us analyze design alternatives and determine a preferred option to upgrade the existing sewer pipe.

We’re committed to engaging with the community during each stage of the project, and we want to make sure everyone has access to information. Scan the QR code or visit the URL to learn more!

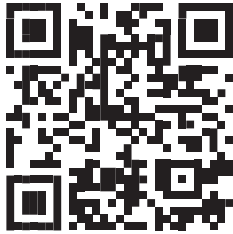
