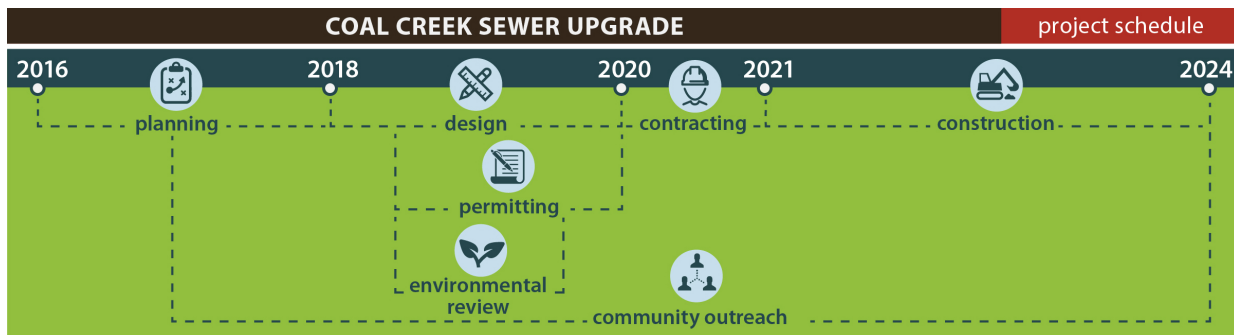
Survey work in the Coal Creek Natural Area beginning March 11

Surveyors will be working in the Coal Creek Natural Area beginning March 11 to collect additional information for King County’s Coal Creek Sewer Upgrade Project. As project design continues, some additional field work will be needed to inform design. We will let you know when field work is scheduled.

The Coal Creek Sewer Upgrade Project will build a new sewer line to provide needed capacity for a growing community. This project also allows us to move much of the active pipeline away from its existing location in Coal Creek. We are early in design, and will be inviting the community to meet with us later this spring and into the summer to learn more about the project.

What to expect during this work:

- Surveyors will be present in the Natural Area and other locations.
- Trails will remain open and no traffic impacts are expected.
- Survey work throughout the project area will take about two weeks.
- **Survey markers will remain in place- please do not disturb them!**
