## Field survey update: Work begins on Coal Creek Parkway Monday, July 15

The schedule has changed for King County Wastewater Treatment Division's contractor to perform field surveys at three locations in Coal Creek Parkway near the Upper West Trailhead at Coal Creek Natural Area(see map on page 3). These surveys are now scheduled to begin Monday, July 15. Drivers can expect delays traveling past the work area, with one lane closures and detours around the work.

Crews will use a truck-mounted drill rig to take samplings of soil and groundwater conditions below the road surface.



A truck-mounted rig will drill up to 155 feet below the surface to take samplings that will inform project design and environmental review.

## What to expect during this work


- Work will take place Monday-Friday, July 15-26, from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.
- Flaggers will direct commuters around a one lane closure by the work area on one lane of Coal Creek Parkway.
- Watch for warning signs prior to the lane closure in each direction!


Please drive slowly to protect yourself, other commuters, and workers!

## **Upper West Trailhead will be closed July 29-30**

Geotechnical surveys will move to the Natural Area on July 29-30. During this time, people will not be able to park at the trailhead, or to access trails in the work area from Forest Drive SE, SE 60<sup>th</sup> Street, or Red Town Trailhead.
