Dear neighbor,

King County is exploring parking and transportation options for the Coal Creek Natural Area when the Upper West/Red Cedar Trailhead is closed for construction. The closure is expected begin when construction starts in 2022 or 2023. The closure will last up to three years.

The Coal Creek project team is seeking feedback from nearby neighbors along Forest Drive Southeast on alternate parking and/or transportation options while the Upper West/Red Cedar Trailhead is closed.
