

KING COUNTY'S COAL CREEK SEWER UPGRADE PROJECT IS COMING TO THE RED CEDAR TRAILHEAD

Construction will close the trailhead for about 3 years.


King County's Coal Creek Sewer Upgrade Project will replace a pipe that serves parts of Bellevue and Newcastle.

The Coal Creek Trunk Sewer pipe has moved wastewater from homes and businesses to a regional treatment plant for over 50 years.

This project provides wastewater capacity for a growing area and gives King County an opportunity to move much of the active pipe away from Coal Creek.

The construction contract is expected to be awarded in late 2023. Once a contractor is on board, we will provide more information on trail closure dates and expected impacts.
