What is SCS Certification?

"SCS Certification is a King County program that helps small businesses increase their competitiveness as contractors, suppliers, and consultants."

Applies to contracts for:

- Goods & Services;
- Consulting Services, and
- Construction



Fast-Track Certification

Businesses certified with the Washington State Office of Minority and Women's Business Enterprises (OMWBE) are automatically eligible for King County SCS certification.

What is Registration

King County E-Procurement Supplier Portal:

- Registration is required and free.
- **All suppliers must register to access the portal to bid or propose for solicitations.**
- County solicitations are conducted via the e-procurement portal.
- User guides are available to assist with registering and navigating the system.





Why Get Registered?

BENEFITS:

- Directly message buyers and submit bids and proposals through the E-Procurement portal.
- Receive email notifications of new solicitations for the commodities you have chosen.
- Receive email notifications when an addendum is issued for solicitations.
- Update your company information and access your historical bid data.
