## Project Update

### Post-construction underwater diving inspection of the outfall pipe this Friday, Oct 7

As part of the Georgetown Wet Weather Treatment Station project, King County Wastewater Treatment Division also completed the construction of a new outfall structure under the First Avenue South Bridge in 2020.

This Friday, October 7, crews will conduct a post-construction underwater inspection of the outfall pipe. King County contractor, Associated Underwater Services, will stage the work from the shoreline area. A vehicle with supporting equipment will likely be positioned nearby along S. River Street to document the condition of the outfall.
