King County to upgrade regional sewer pipelines in Interbay neighborhood

King County is planning to upgrade approximately one mile of its pipeline system extending from the Magnolia Bridge to just north of the Interbay Athletic Complex. Full construction for the project is expected to begin in 2022 with a small repair effort taking place in summer 2020. Learn more about this [project here](#).

Some early construction taking place

Occurring now, summer 2020, the County is reinforcing a 200-foot section of sewer pipe from West Garfield Street (adjacent to the Interbay Pump Station) to just north of the Magnolia Bridge. View the [construction notification and map here](#).

This section of pipe needs to be temporarily reinforced prior to the overall line replacement in 2022. Crews will dig down to the existing pipes and place additional concrete around several pipe joints that have been identified as potential weak spots.

This work will take approximately three months to complete and will not impact access to the Magnolia Bridge or its on and off ramps.
