

Notice 1: Sewer Construction to Start the Week of April 24

King County contractors will begin construction activities to reline a sewer pipe in the Bel Red neighborhood of Bellevue starting the week of April 24. Work will take place in this area of the project through June 2023.

Here's what you'll notice:

- Traffic control set up on 120th Avenue Northeast the week of April 24. Cutting and digging of the roadway to bury the temporary pipe underneath.
- Traffic control set up on 124th Avenue Northeast the week of May 1. Cutting and digging at the King County Metro East Base driveway off 124th.
- As part of <u>King County's Lake Hills sewer relining project</u>, the City of Bellevue will conduct nightly work activities to install casings along 124th Avenue Northeast on May 1-5, from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m. During work hours, you can expect the following:
 - 124th Avenue NE near East Bellevue Metro Base will be closed nightly to through traffic. Electronic message signs near the work zone will inform motorists of closure dates and hours.
 - > The city will maintain access to select businesses on 124th Avenue NE.
- Mobilizing equipment for a system of temporary pumps, pipes, and odor control that will maintain sewer service during construction.
- Closure of a section of the multi-use trail near Sound Transit. Pedestrians will be detoured to a temporary path and bicycles will be detoured to share 120th Avenue Northeast for approximately three months.

What to expect:

- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays with occasional night and weekend work.
- There will be noise and odor from the temporary pumping system and other construction activities.
- Sewer service will be maintained.
