## Notice 3: Four-Day Closure of NE Spring Blvd Eastbound in July/August

King County crews are continuing to work in the Bel Red neighborhood of Bellevue.

[Sewer construction](#) will impact businesses and neighbors along Northeast Spring Boulevard for **four continuous days of work occurring sometime between July 13 and August 1, 2023.**

### Here's what you'll notice:

- **Eastbound closure** of Northeast Spring Boulevard, between 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Northeast and 136<sup>th</sup> Place Northeast. No vehicle or bicycle access on the eastbound side during the four-day closure.
- **Intersection closed** at 134<sup>th</sup> Avenue Northeast and Northeast Spring Boulevard.
- **Detour signs** posted to direct traffic around construction.
- **Flaggers** will be stationed at the intersection of 132<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Northeast and Northeast Spring Boulevard and the intersection of 134<sup>th</sup> Avenue Northeast and Northeast Spring Boulevard.
- Westbound Northeast Spring Boulevard will remain open to vehicles and pedestrians.

### What to expect:

- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays with occasional night and weekend work, however after June 8, contractors will be present onsite 24-hours a day for monitoring and refueling activities.
- There will be noise and odor from the temporary pumping system and other construction activities.
- Sewer service will be maintained.
