

## Survey Update June 8, 2016

Survey crews continue to map property boundaries, utilities, and wetland areas for King County's sewer upgrade project in Redmond. The first phase of field investigations are wrapping up on the West Lake Sammamish/Sammamish River Trail area.

The week of June 6, crews will continue mapping the Idylwood neighborhood east of



In late June, crews will continue surveys along 177th Avenue NE, 180th Avenue NE, and NE 24th Street. Later this summer, survey crews will conduct geotechnical borings in some areas to collect information on soils and ground water. Watch for updates on these activities.

## Did you know?

The Idylwood Neighborhood was once called the Viewpoint Neighborhood. The City of Redmond changed the name in July 2010 after receiving recommendations from a citizen advisory committee and other community members.

Viewpoint Open Space Park. The week of June 13, crews will work in the neighborhood north of Audubon Elementary.

You can expect to see surveyors in bright safety gear working in the right-of-way and on private property where King County has rights-of-entry agreements or easements. Property owners will be provided with advance notice of work on their property.
