

Geotechnical work begins June 23 in Idylwood for King County's sewer upgrade project in Redmond

King County's Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade Project field investigations are in full swing! Survey crews continue to map property boundaries, utilities, and wetland areas, and geotechnical crews will begin soil investigations in Idylwood on June 23. Geotechnical investigations will help the project team evaluate soil and groundwater conditions along the new pipeline alignment.

What you can expect

- **Equipment**. Crews will use drill rigs to perform borings at points along the alignment. Different drill rigs will be used depending on the boring location.
- Crew members or signs directing traffic. Please use caution and drive slowly in the work area.
- Crews will work up to one working day in each location.
- Limited work hours in some locations:
 - Residential areas: 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
 - Northeast 24th Street: 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.
 - West Lake Sammamish Parkway: 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.
- Noise close to the work area. You may hear equipment motors during drilling and intermittent banging noise during sampling at any given time and for no more than 2-3 minutes.
- **Staff will return** to each boring location a week after performing borings and then once every three months to measure groundwater levels.

Locations for geotechnical work in June

*This schedule may change and will be updated throughout field work.

June 23- Borings will occur in the right of way on NE 21st Street by 177th Avenue Northeast and 179th Avenue Northeast close to NE 24th Street. Traffic will be directed around the work.

Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade Project

June 24- Work will occur in Northeast 24th Street east of Viewpoint Open Space. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained, with one lane reserved for work.

June 27- Crews will work on 180th Avenue Northeast south of Northeast 28th Street. The current traffic lanes will be maintained.

June 28- Work will be located at the intersection of Northeast 33rd Street and 179th Avenue Northeast. Traffic will be directed around work.

June 29- Two borings are scheduled, one on 177th Avenue Northeast and one at the intersection of Northeast 34th Street and 179th Avenue Northeast. Traffic will be directed around work.

June 30- Work will be located near Idylwood Beach Park on 177th Avenue Northeast and Northeast 36th Street. Crew member will be on-site to direct pedestrians around the work zone.
