



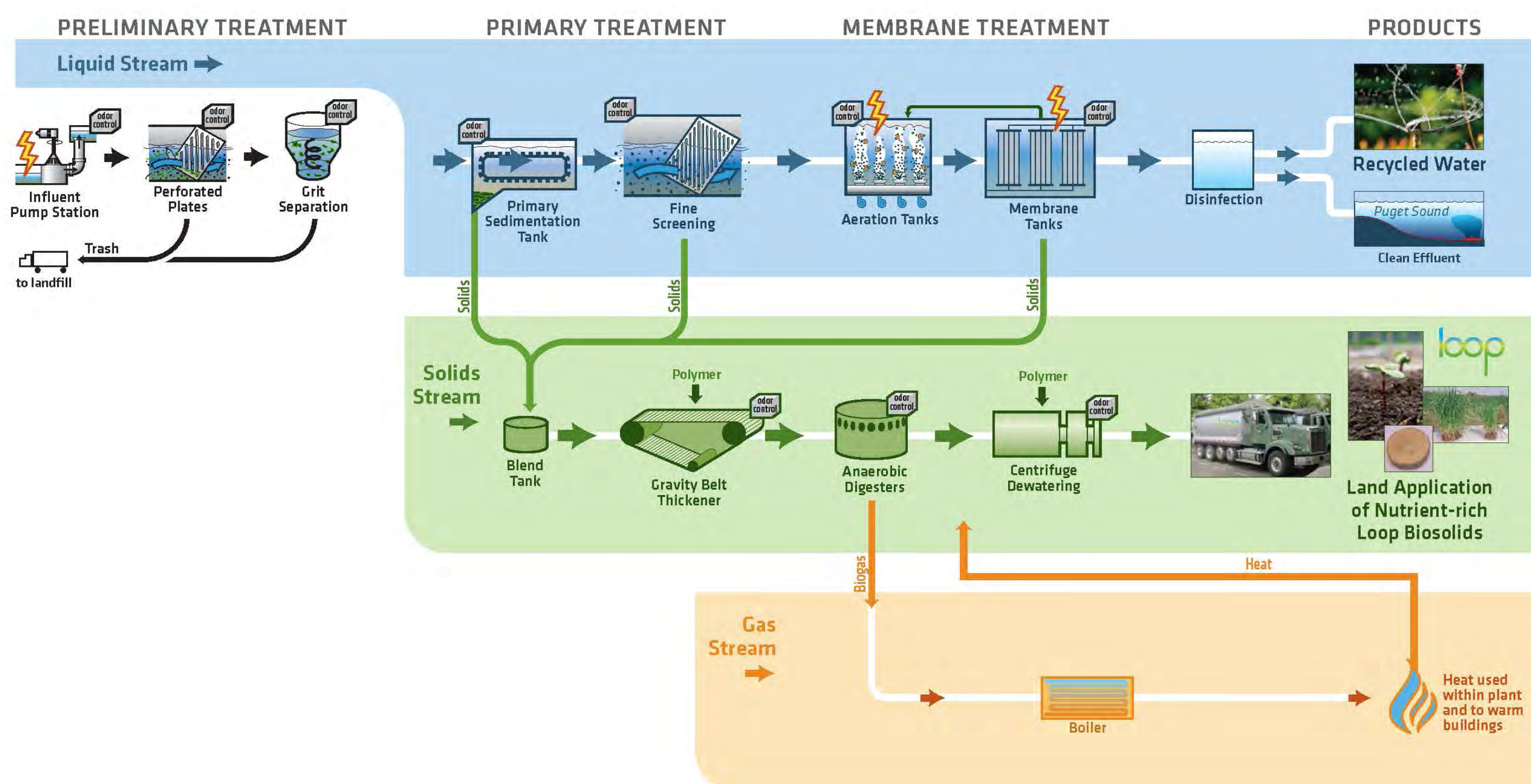
# Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade Project

The trip down the drain is just the first step your wastewater takes to get clean!



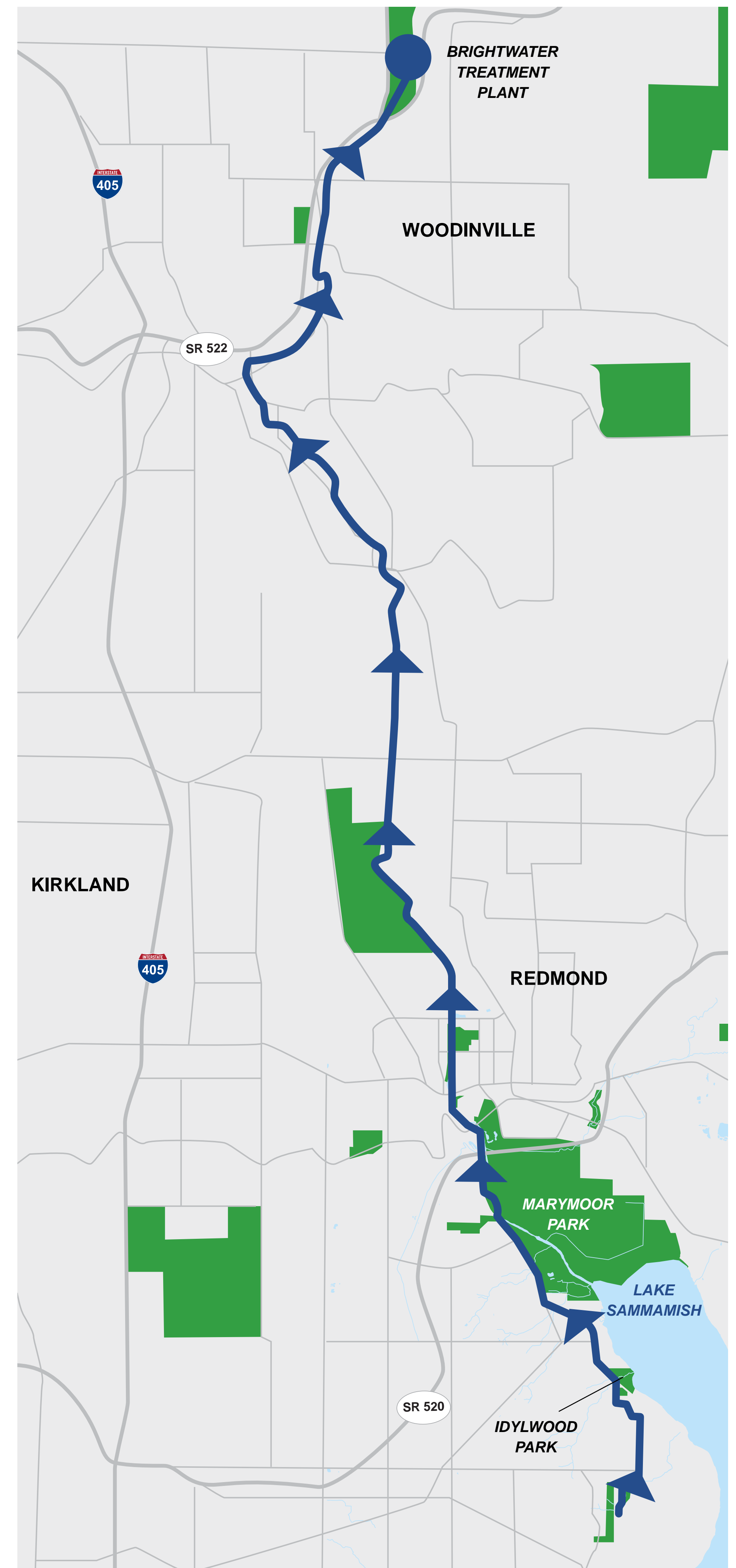
### Brightwater Treatment Process



## Brightwater fast facts

- **Sewage treated daily (in 2015):** 17 million gallons
- **Population served:** 226,000
- **Area served:** 67 square miles
- **Loop Biosolids produced:** 3,254 dry tons
- **Recycled water used or distributed:** 570 million gallons
- **Sequestered carbon:** 4,533 metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent – about the same as taking 1000 cars off the road

The water you use travels down your drain to the City of Redmond's sewer system, then King County's sewer system, and finally Brightwater Treatment Plant in Woodinville for treatment.
