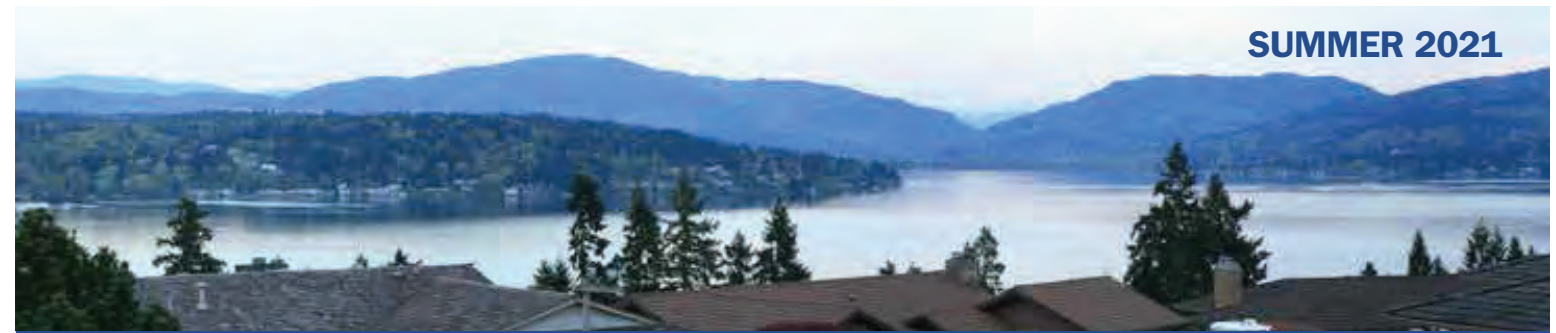
ABOUT THE PROJECT

King County will upgrade a 4.5-mile-long sewer pipe in Redmond. The sewer pipe is aging and needs more capacity to meet the needs of this growing community. Construction is expected to begin in 2024 and take three years to complete. The new pipe will provide sewer service for another 50 years or more.

Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade Project

CONSTRUCTION ▶ EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN 2024

Due to slowdown in the permitting process, construction has been delayed. We now expect construction to begin in 2024.

Over the past year, King County worked to update the design of the sewer upgrade project to meet permitting requirements from the City of Redmond and several local, state, and federal agencies. Coordination with our partner agencies is necessary to make sure we install the new pipe in the safest way possible, limit impacts and maximize improvements for people and the environment.

We expect construction of the 4.5-mile-long project will take about three years. The entire sewer will not be under construction at once. Once we hire a contractor, we will share more detailed information about when the contractor expects to build each part of the sewer. Thank you for your continued patience.

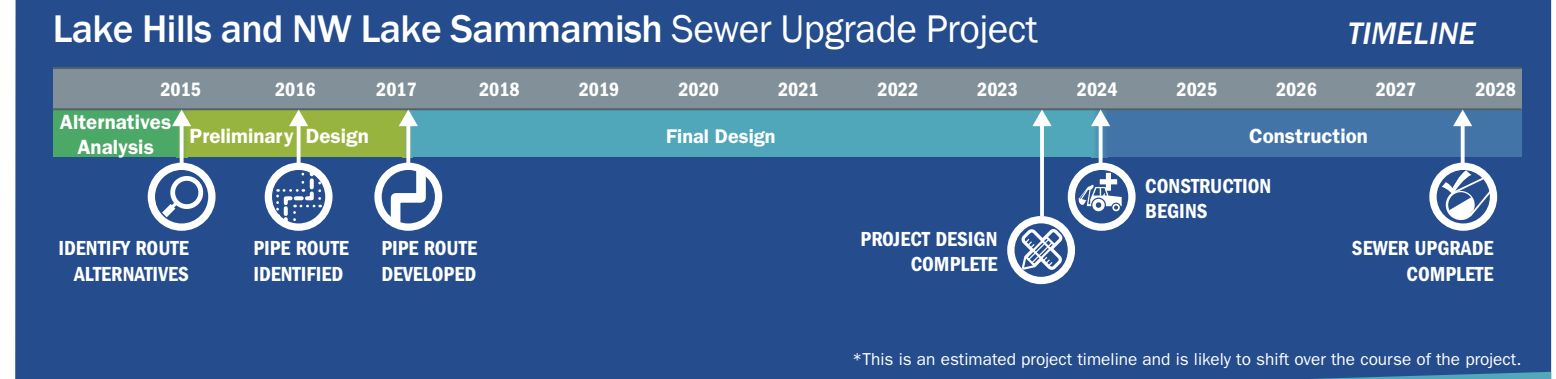

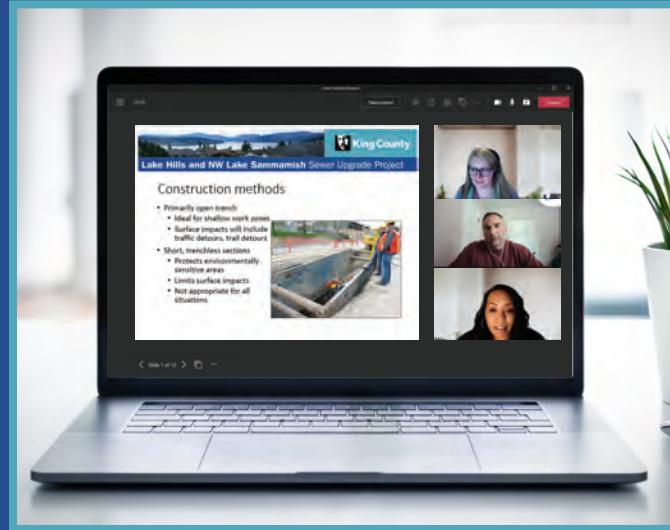
Join us for virtual neighborhood meeting

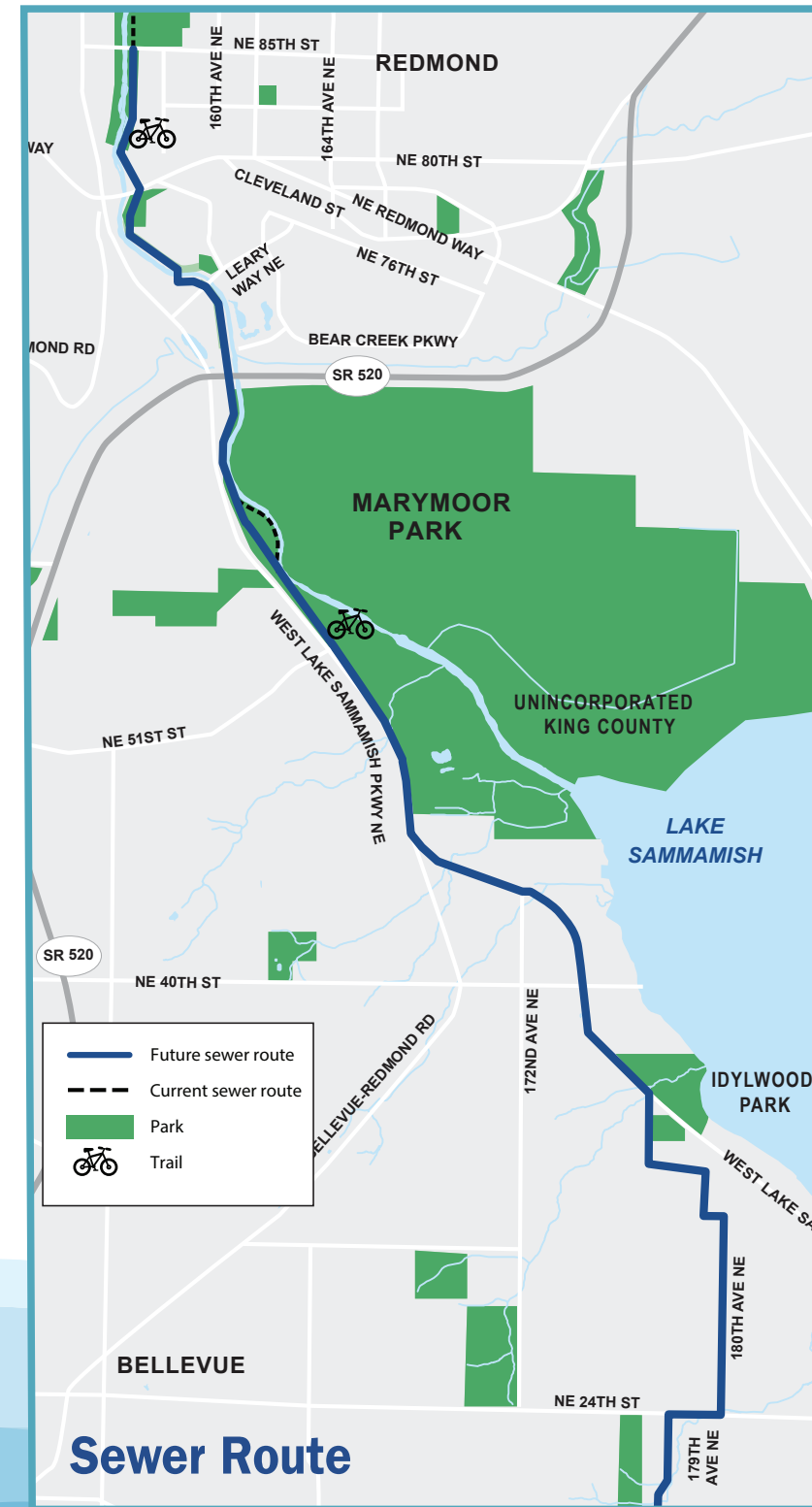
