

Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade Project

Survey work along 177th Ave NE starting as early as May 8

Crews working for King County Wastewater Treatment Division are continuing fieldwork to support final design of the Lake Hills and NW Lake Sammamish Sewer Upgrade project. Starting as early as May 8, crews will use survey equipment to locate underground utilities along 177th Ave NE between West Lake Sammamish Parkway and NE 34th St. Survey activities are expected to take up to one week to complete.

What to expect:

- Work hours 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Crews will use cameras and other handheld equipment to survey utilities
- There will be two surveyors and a work truck
- Sidewalk and pedestrian walkways will be maintained
- Crews will wear high visibility gear
