Construction staging to begin at the North Mercer Pump Station starting next week

As early as Monday, June 27, neighbors near the North Mercer Pump Station will see changes at the pump station as work gets underway. Crews will begin preparing the site for construction by installing erosion control fences to keep dirt and debris from entering the stream that flows near the pump station. Crews will also begin expanding the driveway to make it easier to move trucks and equipment around the site.

We do not anticipate the need for additional signage or flaggers.

What to expect in the next couple of weeks

- Work will occur within permitted hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
 - The work schedule is subject to change depending on weather and other factors.
- Increased construction equipment and trucks hauling materials near the pump station.
- Intermittent increased noise/vibration while materials get delivered to the site.
