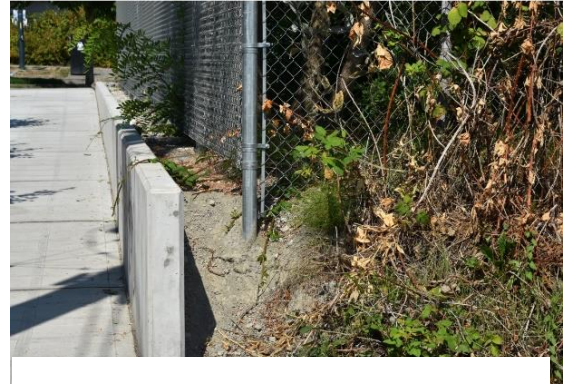

Upcoming construction activities at the North Mercer Pump Station

Neighbors near the North Mercer Pump Station will see increased construction activities in the coming weeks. Starting next week, crews will begin moving in additional heavy machinery to build a temporary retaining wall. This wall is needed to protect the hill behind it. The temporary retaining wall will be replaced with a permanent structure once construction is complete and before the site is landscaped.

Before the temporary wall is constructed, crews will grade and level the western edge of the pump station property starting August 22. Leveling this portion of the property creates a space for the temporary pump station and other construction activities. Neighbors may also notice crews clearing ivy and other plants to the east of the existing pump station.



We do not anticipate the need for additional signage or flaggers.

What to expect in the next couple of weeks

- Work will occur within permitted hours: 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and, as needed, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday
 - Schedule is subject to change depending on weather and other factors
- Increased construction equipment and trucks hauling materials near the pump station
- Intermittent increased noise/vibration while materials get delivered to the site
- Increased noise while heavy construction equipment is operating on site during work hours
