Work on temporary pump station continues Temporary generator running the week of June 12

Upcoming work at the North Mercer Pump Station:

For a few days the week of June 12, a temporary generator will run continuously at the North Mercer Pump Station. At least one staff member will be on site 24/7 to monitor the temporary generator while it is running. Noise from the generator is not expected to be louder than what is typical for construction activities.

The generator will maintain power while the temporary pump station is connected to new electrical service. This week, crews are preparing the pump station for this electrical work*.

Additionally, crews continue to install pipe and other underground structures to support operations of the temporary pump station during construction.

*Construction schedules can change based on factors such as site conditions, weather, and crew/material availability. We will notify you in advance of any major changes to the planned schedule.



An example of what electrical work at the pump station might look like.

What to expect:

- All work will be performed at the North Mercer Pump Station.
- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
- Noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
 - Continuous noise while heavy construction equipment is operating on site.
- There will be construction equipment and trucks hauling materials on roads near the Pump Station.
