



NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project

August 2023

Tree removal beginning along North Mercer Way and I-90 trail Tree removal between 84th Avenue Southeast and Shorewood Drive will begin as early as August 14.

Crews will begin removing trees along the I-90 trail work areas to make space for construction. We are coordinating directly with the City of Mercer Island about tree protection, removal, and restoration. As a part of this project, we will plant 600 new trees across Mercer Island to replace the nearly 400 trees we removed. Read our Plan for Trees factsheet to learn more.

What to expect:

- Crews will first mark trees for removal.
- Crews will then cut the trees into pieces and load them into a truck

- The area surrounding trees will be restored after removal.
- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday for the duration of this work.*
- Noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
- Intermittent/continuous noise and vibration during tree removal and stump grinding.
- We will detour people walking and biking on the I-90 trail around active work areas.

*Construction schedules can change based on factors such as site conditions, weather, and crew/material availability. We will notify you in advance of any major changes to the planned schedule.
