

NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project

September 2023

Paving beginning on 90th Place Southeast.

Crews will prepare and pave 90th Place Southeast to return the road to its previous condition. These activities may cause additional vibration. For more information regarding construction on 90th Place S.E., see our previous notice.

Today through October 3, including work on Saturday September 30: Crews will remove asphalt and prepare the roadway for paving. This will include demoing asphalt driveway approaches that have been impacted by construction.

During this time, the roadway will be rough and unfinished. Please drive slowly!

Paving is scheduled to take place on October 4, 9, and 10*: Crews will start paving at the cul-desac and work their way towards Shorewood Drive. We anticipate that work should take approximately one day to complete. However, some paving activities are weather dependent. We plan to pave as much as possible on October 4. If weather or time constraints do not allow completion, October 9 and 10 are back up paving days.

We expect asphalt work to begin around 7:30 a.m. on October 4. Once crews begin, they cannot stop or allow cars to drive on freshly laid asphalt. During this time, driveways will be temporarily inaccessible. Crews are holding parking spots for neighbors at the bottom of 90th PL S.E. and on 89th PL S.E. Crews will walk neighbors up and down the street to cars.

To help our team coordinate parking, please place a paper with your phone number on the dash of your car so we can contact you if needed.

Following repaying, we expect remaining construction will include landscape restoration and work on our underground structures within the cul-de-sac. Impacts to near neighbors will be intermittent.

*Construction schedules can change based on factors such as site conditions, weather, and crew/material availability.

What to expect:

- All work will be performed in the public right-of-way.
 - We will not access private property unless we have a signed agreement.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Permitted work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
 O Work outside these hours will be done as approved by the City of Mercer Island.
- There will be noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
- Garbage, recycling, composting, mail, and delivery service will be maintained.
