Preparation activities beginning at the Mercer Island Boat Launch

One lane of alternating traffic on Frontage Road as early as May 15:

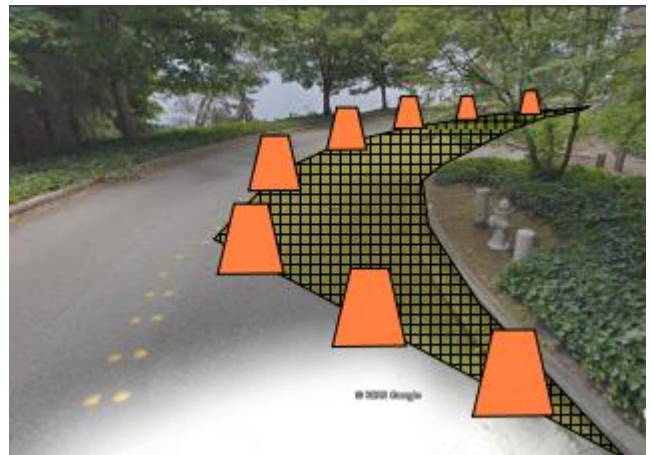
Starting as early as May 11, we will remove trees and vegetation along Frontage Road to make space for pipeline installation. As early as May 15, we will need to close a lane of traffic to make space for crews, equipment, and materials. Once the site is prepared for construction, we will install below ground structures that will support future operations.

The new pipes and structures will connect pipes from Mercer Island and Bellevue:

What to expect during construction:

- All work will be performed in the public right-of-way.
- Access to the boat launch and parking area will be always maintained.
- Starting as early as May 15, traffic will be controlled by flaggers or automated signals during permitted work hours.
 - When it is safe to do so, we will restore regular traffic flow outside of typical work hours.
- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
 - Work outside these hours will be done as approved by the City of Mercer Island.
- There will be noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
