

NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project

February 2024

Frontage Road and Mercer Island Boat Launch closed for up to three Fridays and Saturdays as early as February 9

On Friday, February 9 and Saturday, February 10, Frontage Road and the Mercer Island Boat Launch will be closed to public access for sewer pipe installation. Closures are also planned for Saturday, February 17 and 24. Crews need to install sewer pipe along a section of Frontage Road to connect the pipe from Southeast 35th Place to the pipe running underwater in Lake Washington's East Channel.

Access for pedestrians, emergency vehicles, and driveways on Frontage Road will be maintained during these Friday and Saturday closures. Frontage Road and the Mercer Island Boat Launch will reopen as soon as this work is completed.

What to expect during construction:

- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturdays.
- Saturday work may be extended to 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. with approval from the City of Mercer Island.
- All work will be performed in the public right-of-way.
- Noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Construction schedules can change based on factors such as site conditions, weather, and material availability.
