Trenchless pipe installation off 97th Avenue Southeast starts as early as February 12

Crews will use trenchless jack and bore drilling method to continue installing pipe in the area.

As early as February 12, crews will mobilize into the area and begin preparing for work activities.

As early as February 15, crews will begin excavating two pits, one on 97th Avenue Southeast and one on private property to the west.

As early as February 19, crews will place a boring machine in one of the pits and push casing through the ground while cutting without disturbing the surface.

This method reduces impacts to traffic and home access in the area, compared to the traditional method of digging a large trench for the pipe. If you live nearby, you may experience increased vibration or noise as crews are excavating the pit areas and drilling underground. Completing this portion of the work is expected to take approximately two months.



The red dotted line marks the approximate path the pipe will take during trenchless pipe installation.

What to expect during construction:

- Typical work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
- Noise, dust, and vibrations typical of an active construction project.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Garbage, recycling, composting, and mail service will be maintained.
