Water pressure reduction affecting your home starting as early as April 10

As early as Wednesday, April 10, the City of Mercer Island will reduce water pressure in your neighborhood as part of King County's sewer upgrade project. This will affect seventeen homes on El Dorado Beach Club Drive, Briarwood Lane, and Southeast 35th Place.

Reducing water pressure is necessary to maintain crew safety when working on utilities in your neighborhood. Neighbors may notice a decrease in water pressure when using multiple water sources like the dishwasher, laundry, and shower at once.

Water pressure is estimated to be reduced for up to six weeks and your water service will be maintained.

What to expect:

- All work will be performed in the public right-of-way.
- Water service will be maintained.
- Possible decrease in water pressure while using all water sources at once for up to six weeks.
