Construction update: Expect intermittent loud noises and/or vibrations

Hammering to begin near Sweyolocken Boat launch

As soon as August 24, crews will begin drilling the new sewer pipeline that runs under the Enatai hillside. An early step is to insert a steel case near the drilling entrance that will allow the rest of the work to begin. Crews will pound the steel case in with what is known as a pneumatic hammer.

While this work is happening you may notice additional noise and vibration.

What to expect during pneumatic hammering:

- Work will occur within permitted hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday.
- Intermittent loud noise and/or vibration during hammering
- Increased construction equipment and trucks hauling materials on roads near the boat launch.
