



NORTH MERCER ISLAND/ENATAI Sewer Upgrade Project

Survey work begins on Mercer Island September 19

Starting Monday, September 19, King County's project team will begin survey work on Mercer Island. You may see crews in yellow vests using survey equipment to map the project area on the I-90 Trail and in residential areas nearby. Work will take place during daytime hours, Monday through Friday, and will continue into early October.

Crews will not be working in the road, so we do not expect any traffic impacts associated with this work. I-90 Trail users may see signs or orange cones on the trail to warn of upcoming survey crews, but the trail will remain open.

These surveys will help our team have an accurate understanding of ground conditions in the area as we continue early design for the North Mercer Island and Enatai Sewer Upgrade Project.

Please watch for equipment and signs in the area and travel slowly to stay safe.
