Overview

To construct the North Mercer Island and Enatai Sewer Upgrade Project, King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD) will install the Bellevue portion of a new wastewater pipeline using Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) and rehabilitate a portion of the existing pipeline using cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation. WTD will use the CIPP rehabilitation method in the water from Enatai Beach Park to the Sweyolocken Pump Station. Below the Enatai Hillside, WTD will use the HDD trenchless construction method.
