As part of the North Mercer Island and Enatai Sewer Upgrade Project, King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD) will rehabilitate a portion of the existing pipeline using cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation. WTD will use the CIPP rehabilitation method in the water from Enatai Beach Park to the Sweyolocken Pump Station. Part of that works includes installation of grinder pumps on waterfront properties to divert sewage to functioning pipes while the work is occurring.
