During the walk, the team will share the detailed route for the sewer upgrade and answer questions.


We'll walk rain or shine, so please dress for the weather and wear sturdy shoes for walking.

S.E. 24th Street to North Mercer Way




Meet at the corner of 78th Avenue SE and S.E. 24th Street at 12:30 p.m. (A).
