Tree survey work beginning November 5

As early as November 5, King County Wastewater Treatment Division will be surveying trees in the Enatai neighborhood and Mercer Slough. This work will help identify tree species and proximity to areas within the North Mercer Island/Enatai Sewer Upgrade Project working limits.



What you can expect for tree survey work:

- Work hours typically 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekdays.
- Work expected to take up to three days.
- Up to two crew members in high visibility vests using measuring tapes and notebooks to survey trees and record data.
- During tree survey, some trees will receive tree tags, aluminum nails with a tag that the tree will grow over.
- King County has notified property owners ahead of any work on private property.
