The King County Wastewater Treatment Division is conducting a study of the sewer system in the Thornton Creek Basin to identify where groundwater or stormwater may be seeping into sewer pipes throughout the project study area. This study is helping King County to determine where we can make investments to improve the regional sewer system and reduce overflows.

Work will occur beginning in October 2021 and will continue into early next year. The work will include inspecting maintenance holes and examining sewer main pipes from public rights of way.
