Soil sampling work near First Avenue South Bridge beginning April 8, 2024.

King County Wastewater Treatment Division is building a wet weather storage tank near the intersection of Southwest Michigan Street and Second Avenue Southwest to reduce combined sewer overflows into the Duwamish River.

Starting as early as April 1, 2024, crews will begin visiting the project site to mark the locations of existing utilities. Crews will spend up to two business days drilling to collect soil samples. Once drilling is complete, crews will restore the surrounding surface. This work will help our team to better understand soil conditions below the project site.

This work will occur at the storage facility site (see map to right).

What you can expect

- Crews visiting the site in the week prior to drilling, as soon as April 1, 2024; this work will not involve vibration, noise, or traffic impacts.
- Work hours 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily for up to two days, starting as early as April 8, 2024.
- One drill rig and up to four service vehicles on site.
