

Project update

Having refined the project design, conducted an environmental review, and acquired permits and property rights, the project team is now entering into the construction phase, beginning in April. We will continue to provide updates to prepare the community for any impacts of the construction. (See “What to Expect” below.)

Over the past year, we have:

- Developed designs for the removal of the existing roof structure and other upgrades needed to meet required seismic safety for the sedimentation basins.
- Begun planning for somewhat increased truck traffic in Discovery Park and other local streets by: performing a study to ensure that construction trucks don’t cause road blockage or closures, placing limits on trucks’ weight to reduce damage to roadways, and placing restrictions on construction truck and equipment noise levels and hours of operation.
- Obtained required permits from the City of Seattle, and state and federal agencies

We will continue to keep the community up to date, answer questions, hear your input, and address concerns. The team is committed to continuing outreach during the design phase and into construction. We will be reaching out to the community to find the best way to keep in touch with you!
