This Addendum provides the following clarifications and additional information about the referenced solicitation.

Q1. Can a grant proposal be for an amount besides \$1000 or \$5000?

A1. Proposals can be for \$1,000 up to \$20,000 in \$5,000 increments, i.e. \$1,000, \$5,000, \$10,000, \$15,000, or \$20,000.

A3. No application will be rejected for asking for the max of \$20,000. Feel free to apply for the \$20k, knowing that if evaluators feel you have an exemplary program but can't "afford" to offer the full amount, the Program Manager will work with you to negotiate a smaller scope of work and smaller grant award.
