

CERTIFIED BOOTH OPERATOR APPLICATION

A Certified Booth Operator is required for each business with a multiple or unlimited moderate/complex temporary food permit. The certificate holder is not required to be on site during the event. <u>Preregistration is required</u>.

The course fee is \$101 per person, to be paid in advance. The certification is good for two years.
