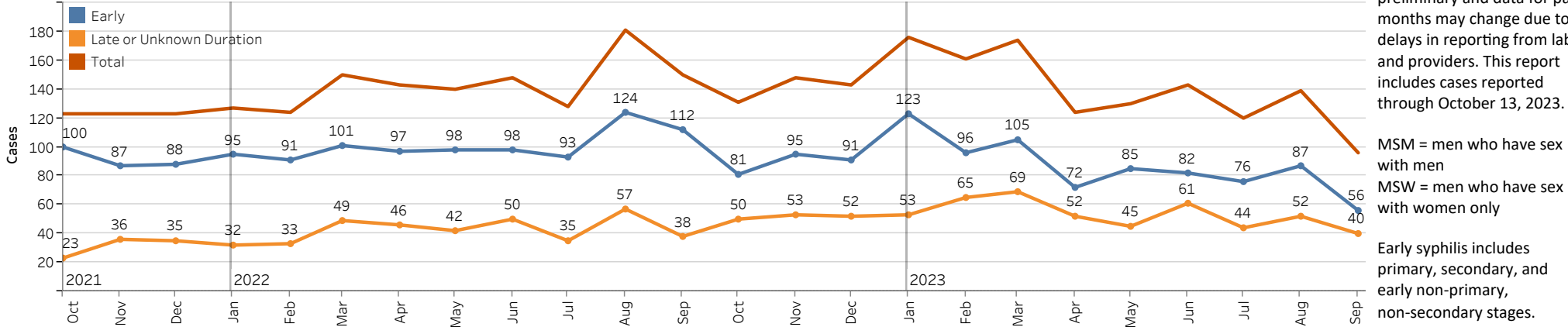


Seattle and King County Monthly Syphilis Report: September 2023

*Note: All data are preliminary and data for past months may change due to delays in reporting from labs and providers. This report includes cases reported through October 13, 2023.

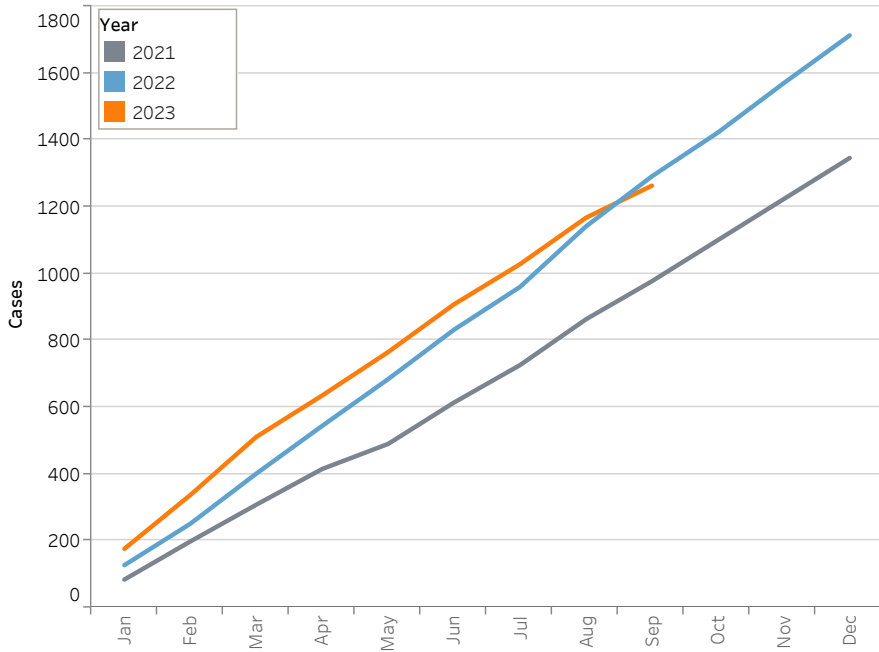
Syphilis Cases by Stage, King County October 2021-September 2023



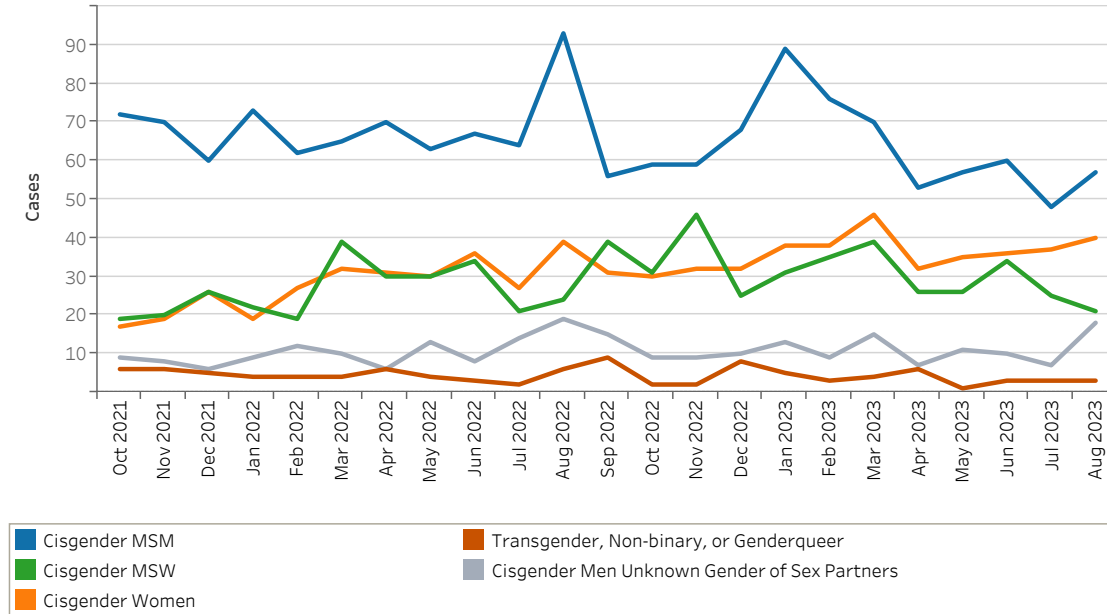
MSM = men who have sex with men

**Due to incomplete reporting cases for the most recent month are not shown by gender and gender of sex partners.

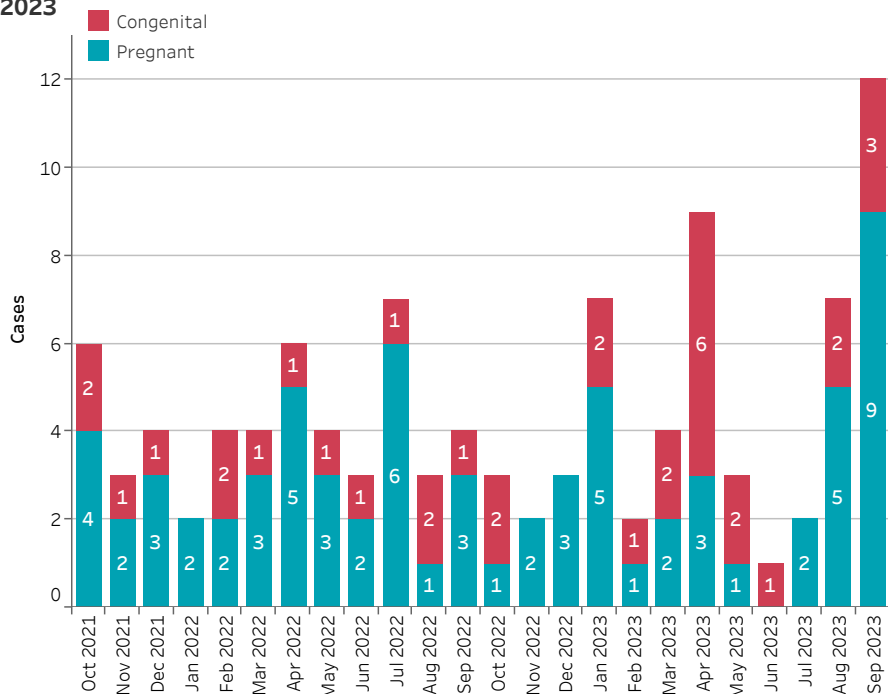
