
AGING IS A WORK OF ART: A VINTAGE SEPTIC SYSTEM NEEDS REGULAR MAINTENANCE!

Maintenance is the key!

Vintage systems should be regularly inspected and pumped. They may have issues if they haven't been checked in a long time.

Avoid septic additives & keep trash out

Avoid using additives that claim to extend the life of the system, such as bacterial additives or chemicals to unclog pipes. Plus, keep food waste or other trash out of your drain; they belong in the garbage.
