Summary of change	Reason for change	Code section	Key considerations
Evaluate how to best manage holding tanks to prevent raw sewage discharges	Holding tanks are increasingly used for non-commercial purposes and represent a high public health risk when not pumped (which happens with a relatively high frequency).	13.52	Limit cost and time impact to property owners Consider feasibility for maintenance providers

Evaluate public health risk of tanks over decks and more closely align requirements with anticipated impacts on OSS	Code is likely unnecessarily restrictive, and the intent can be met without this requirement.	13.28	Are current requirements adding unnecessary steps and costs?
