

UDS report submission & financial measures - Governance Council update

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The Uniform Data System (UDS) report is submitted annually to our Federal grantor, Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA). The UDS report combines all our patient and visit information with our financial information for each calendar year. This is an update on the financial measures we reported for 2023.

The UDS report is due each year on February 15th, covering the prior calendar year. Each health center then works with a HRSA-contracted UDS reviewer to finalize the report, usually by mid-March. Our 2023 report was submitted by the due date, and then reviewed and approved by the reviewer. We met our overall goal of 95% of our HRSA patient target – we served 21,838 unduplicated patients in 2023, toward our patient target of 21,957, or 99%.

Prior year comparison reports show how our Health Center compares to State and national grantees in total, and with other homeless grantees. The table below shows these measures for 2022. Our costs are right in line with state and national averages.

2023 UDS financial measures submitted

PHSKC’s submitted 2023 UDS report shows the following figures, both of which are slightly lower than in 2022. Summary and comparison from all 2022 health center reports will be available late summer 2024.

Total cost per patient: \$1238.37

Total cost per visit: \$234.40

*This column is the average of 77 health centers nationally with 25% or more of their patient population who are experiencing homelessness.
