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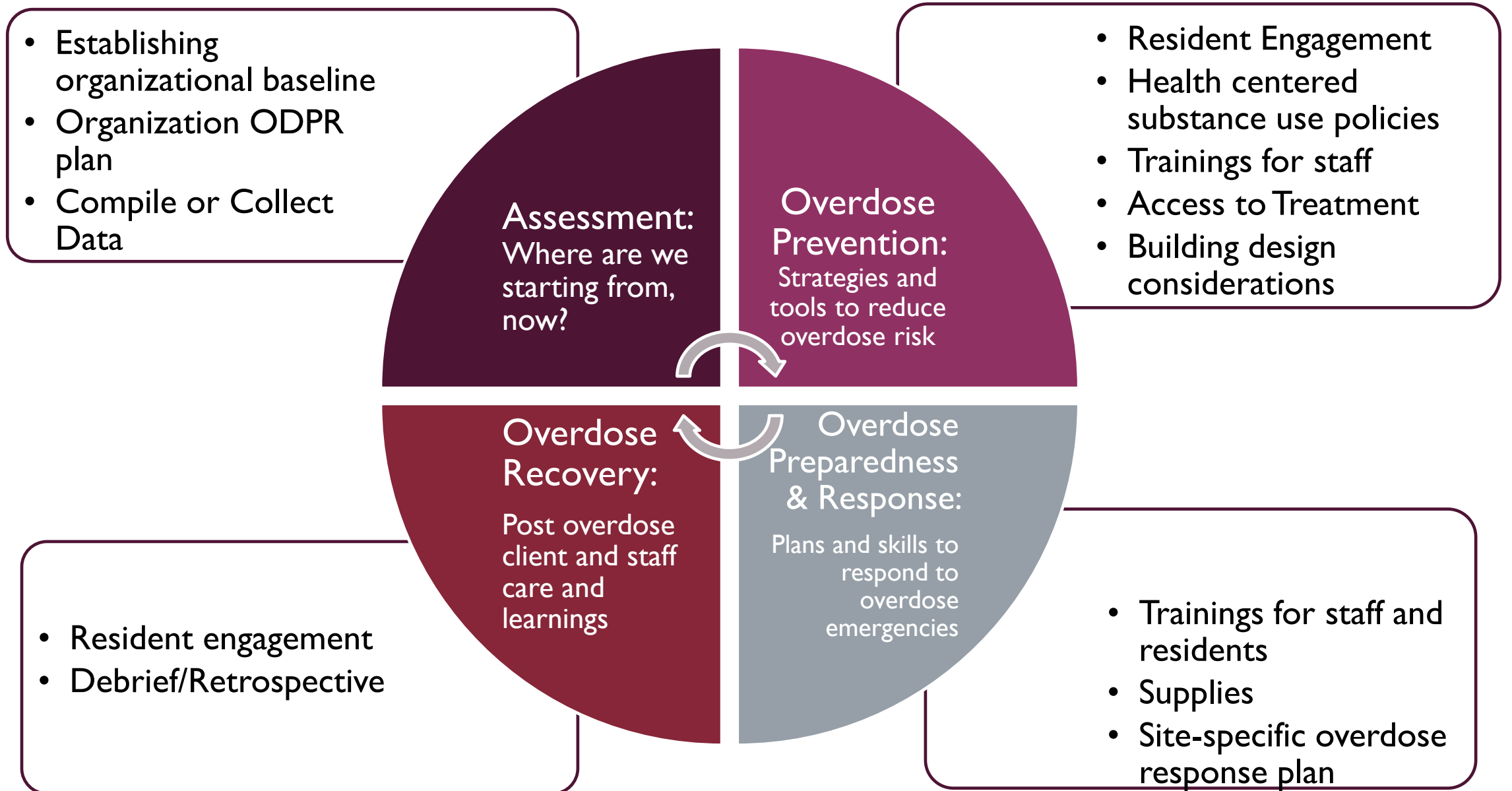




OVERVIEW

- PHSKC is **one of the first** public health departments in the country to build and enhance programming specific to supporting publicly funding housing providers.
- In January we **convened system partners and housing providers** to kick-off these efforts.
- We are also expanding efforts to **coordinate place-based responses** with community partners.

- Collaborating with **seven organizations** who expressed interest in piloting novel interventions
