Fentanyl is a very strong opioid. A small amount (just the size of 2 grains of salt) can cause a deadly overdose within seconds of hitting your system. Naloxone is a legal and widely available medication that can reverse opioid overdoses.

Overdoses can happen fast. Learn how to administer naloxone ahead of time: you could save your friend's life.

3 YOU COULD SAVE YOUR FRIEND'S LIFE

When someone overdoses, they're not able to administer naloxone to themselves. Just like designated drivers save people from getting in car accidents, YOU might save people from overdosing accidents. Let friends know that you carry naloxone, because friends don't let friends use alone.
