

Alternative Verification using the Online Ballot Marking Program (OBMP)

During the April 2025 Special Election, you may verify your OBMP ballot with your Washington State ID or driver's license number, or the last four digits of your Social Security Number, instead of signing the return envelope.

ALTERNATIVE VERIFICATION USING OBMP

- 1 Go to kce.wiki/OBMP
- 2 Select Mark and Print Your Ballot
- 3 Under "Yes, I want to provide ID information to verify my ballot," select Continue
- 4 Enter your name and birthdate.
- 5 Select the bubble to mark whether you are an overseas or service voter.
- 6 Read the ballot declaration. Check the box beside "I attest to the ballot declaration." Select Continue.
- 7 Enter your Washington State ID or driver's license number OR enter the last four digits of your social security number.
- 8 Mark your ballot online OR print and mark your ballot.
 - To mark your ballot online, follow the instructions on the screen. When you are finished marking your choices, click Continue.
 - To print and mark your printed ballot, click "click here to print and mark your ballot."
- 9 Click Download ballot packet.
- 10 Print your downloaded ballot packet.



Don't forget to return your ballot!

Ballots must be returned by 8 p.m. sharp on Election Day, April 22.
