## Letter of Understanding to the Master Community Workforce Agreement Between

## Seattle King County Building & Construction Trades Council & Western States Regional Council of Carpenters & King County

In consideration of the covenants contained in the existing Master Community Workforce Agreement (MCWA), it is mutually agreed upon by all parties that the original terms and conditions of the MCWA executed on February 11, 2020 ("original MCWA") will remain in effect for the following projects:

- GCCM Services for South Plant Influent Pump Upgrade Project KC001387
- RapidRide I-Line Bus Rapid Transit Improvements KC001396
- PDB Services for So Interceptor Rehabilitation KC001390

• Cedar Hills Regional Landfill Area 5 & 6 Top Deck Preparation - KC001349

Additionally, the parties desire to extend and continue the original MCWA for an additional term for the above projects not to exceed sixty-five (65) days, commencing upon the expiration date of the original MCWA to allow sufficient time for all parties to execute a new MCWA. The parties agree the terms and conditions of the original MCWA will remain unchanged during this period and that the terms and conditions of the new MCWA, after being fully executed by the parties, will apply thereafter and shall be incorporated into the contracts for the above-referenced projects via Change Order.

<u>Authority:</u> The Seattle King County Building & Construction Trades Council and Western States Regional Council of Carpenters represent that they have full authority to sign the Letter of Understanding on behalf of and bind the Local Unions.
