**WHEREAS**, the current Executive Policy, Procedure and Public Rule System was enacted on July 1, 1987 by INF 7-1-AEP, revised May 19, 1989 by INF 7.1.1-AEP and revised January 11, 2016 by INF-7-3 EO.

**WHEREAS**, the directive in INF 7-3-EO requires all ratified and reenacted polices and rules to expire five years from the effective date of the order or on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2021.

**WHEREAS**, the Permitting Division of the Department of Local Services will be amending various permitting, zoning and land use codes during 2021 and 2022 that relate to the division's public rules.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I Dow Constantine, King County Executive, do hereby order and direct:


