





Data Governance

Strategic Outcomes

- Establish consistent data governance throughout all county agencies and departments, including roles and responsibilities
- Intentionally practice programmatic, ongoing data management and stewardship - everyone has a role






SAC Action

- · Overcoming the lack of trust


Proposed Strategy Approach


